Lesson 13: Divine Guidance

Memory Verse: Ephesians 5:17, "So then do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is."

God is Sovereign and has a purpose for all of His creation with a plan or "will" for each of us. Often times we make His will more difficult to respond to than it really is.

I. God's Will- The bible portrays two aspects of God's will: sovereign will and commanded will. In God's sovereignty, He has a plan that covers all aspects of creation and time. He also has a commanded will That He legislates to His people.

A. The Meaning of God's Will

1. God's sovereign will- God's sovereign will involves His ultimate, complete control over			
	everything. Nothing happens that is not in God's plan. History is really the unfolding of God's		
	purposes, which happen exactly as He planned. (Look up these verses and write out the key
